AMENDMENT TO THE NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULEMAKING

OVERVIEW

The Acupuncture Board (hereinafter referred to as the “Board”) commenced the rulemaking process on January 31, 2020, by providing notice of the proposed rulemaking by posting the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, Proposed Language, and Initial Statement of Reasons on its website. The purpose of this Amended Notice is to correct how the proposed rulemaking was noticed, properly provide the proposed text to all interested parties, and provide a new comment period.

WRITTEN COMMENT PERIOD

Any interested person, or his or her authorized representative, may submit written comments relevant to the proposed regulatory action to the Board. The written comment period closes on November 3, 2020 (45 days after the published date of September 18, 2020). The Board will consider only comments received at the Board’s office by that time. The Board has not scheduled a public hearing on this proposed action.
