NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the California Acupuncture Board (Board) has proposed modifications to the text of Division 13.7, Title 16, California Code of Regulations Sections 1399.407, 1399.407.1, 1399.407.2, and 1399.407.3 (formerly 1399.480, 1400.1, 1400.2, and 1400.3), relating to the implementation of Assembly Bill 2699.
